You will receive the first written communication on October 13th, 2017. It will include comments and observations about your child's learning and behavior.

First Report Card

The first report card will be sent home with your child on November 21st, 2017. The report card will cover the period from August 31st, 2017 to November 3rd, 2017 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Second Report Card

The second report card will be sent home with your child on February 27th, 2017. The report card will cover the period from November 6th, 2017 to February 19th, 2018 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Third Report Card

The third report card will be sent home to you, prior to July 15th, 2018. It will cover the period from February 13th, 2018 to June 22nd, 2018 and will count for 60% of the student's final mark. The final marks for all subjects will be indicated on this report card.
